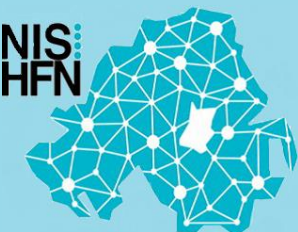


## Reach Out – Minor Surgery Course Pilot
