Clinical Human Factors Course – 12th March 2018

NISHFN Ran their first ever Human Factors Course on Monday 12th March 2018 at the Simulation Suite in Elliot Dynes, Royal Victoria Hospital Site. This was an inter-professional course which was delivered to 14 candidates from different levels and backgrounds to include psychiatry, paediatrics, anaesthetics, dentistry, nursing & academic backgrounds. The faculty who were also from a multi-professional background taught on a range of topics to include:

- Human Fallibility & Error management
- Situational awareness & self awareness
- Team working, leadership & active followership
- Critical communication & assertiveness
- Cognitive processing and Emotional Intelligence
- Resilience and Organisational Culture

This was delivered in an interactive way through a range of group exercises. There were also 2 simulation scenarios after lunch which were used as a vantage to draw out & develop on some of the learning from the morning session.
